GIVEN RECIPE—Class 16

BANANA & WALNUT LOAF

8ozs Self Raising Flower

6 ozs Castor Sugar

Quarter teaspoon Bicarbonate of Soda

2 beaten Eggs

3ozs Margarine

3 well ripened Bananas

2ozs chopped Walnuts

Method

Grease and line a 2lb loaf tin, sift flour and bicarbonate of soda in bowl.

Beat margarine & sugar until light & fluffy.

Add eggs alternately with flour. Mash bananas & add chopped walnuts.

Spoon into prepared tin & smooth. Bake in preheated oven 180c/350f /gas 5

Bake for 1 hour 15 mins. Invert onto wire rack and cool

* a few walnuts can be sprinkled on top before baking if desired
