Caledonian Showing Championships

The Caledonian Showing Championships are now well established in the showing calendar and will once again give 2019 competitors the opportunity to compete at a top-level Championship Final in Scotland.

Evening Performances loads of bling and razzmatazz everything an end of season Championship should have! This year's show will be held at

Highfield @ Howe, near Ladybank, Fife on 12/13th October 2019

This Show is a qualifier and every horse & pony placed 1st and 2nd in all Inhand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line. Qualification is for the Horse & Pony except for Adult/Young Handler classes, where the Handler qualifies.

All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Show's website www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com where you will also find a regularly updated list of qualifying shows as well as a wealth of other information.

TSR Showing Finals:

This show is a qualifier for the 2019 TSR showing finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, South East, Wales & South West or Scottish. You do not have to be a TSR Member to qualify or enter a Final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals. TSR Finals: 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals: The 2 highest placed handlers with a TSR in hand card will qualify in any in hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the Judge/Steward. Cards are available FREE from the TSR web site.

Land Rover Blair Castle International Horse Trials Working Hunter Pony Championship:

Classes 74-76 are qualifiers. Ponies placed first to third in each class will qualify for the Championship held at Land Rover Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Thursday 22nd August 2019. Qualification may go down to sixth place if higher ponies have previously qualified.

Land Rover Blair Castle International Horse Trials Bidwells Ridden Clydesdale Championship

To be judged as a ridden hunter class this class is a Qualifier for the Bidwells ridden Clydesdale Championship to be held at Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Sunday 25th August 2019 the first two in each class to qualify.

Qualification may go down to fourth place, if the horses placed 1st and 2nd have previously qualified. Registered Clydesdales and those eligible for registration may qualify and enter for the championship

Festival Scotland 2019:

This show is affiliated to Festival Scotland 2019 Championships.

The top 3 not already qualified within the top 6 placings will receive a qualification card. Qualification cards entitle the competitor to enter all classes at both the Scotland and England Summer Championships in 2019. RING 1– 9AM PROMPT

£6 PER CLASS (PRE-ENTRY)

- 1 BEST TURNED OUT PONY AND RIDER.** Open to ponies 4 years old and over not exceeding 148cms. Rider aged 16 years and under. **Winner to receive the Just Luke Trophy donated by Fiona Lamont.**
- 2 RIDING CLUB PONIES.** Open to ponies 4 yrs. and over not exceeding 148cms. Riders aged 16 years and under. A small jump may be included at the judge's discretion. **Winner to receive the Shaz Perpetual Trophy.**
- 3 MIXED HEIGHT SHOW HUNTER PONY/INTERMEDIATE,** mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year and be a suitable size for the pony they ride. Under either BSPS or P(UK) rules. **Winner to receive the Silver Springs Trophy donated by Judith Reid.**
- 4 MIXED HEIGHT SHOW PONY/ INTERMEDIATE,** mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year and be a suitable size for the pony they ride. Under either BSPS or P(UK) rules.
- 5 BEST RIDER.** Open to ponies 4 yrs. and over not exceeding 148cms. Riders aged 16 years and under. **Winner to receive the Best Rider Shield.**
- 6 FAMILY PONY.** Open to ponies 4 yrs. and over not exceeding 148cms. Class will be judged as true family pony type suitable to be ridden by any family member. Snaffle bridles only.

- 7 Novice Ridden M&M** Open to Registered or unregistered breeds. Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years old and over. Not to have won more than 3 open M&M class before 1st January 2019 to be shown in snaffle bridles only.
- 8 RIDDEN SMALL BREEDS.** Open to Registered or unregistered breeds. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over.
- 9 RIDDEN LARGE BREEDS.** Open to Registered or unregistered breeds. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over.
- 10 IN HAND MIXED HEIGHT M&M.** Open to Registered or unregistered breeds. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over.
- 11 M&M YOUNGSTOCK.** Open to Registered or unregistered Breeds. Stallion, mare or gelding 3 years and under. Class will be split into large and small breeds if numbers suffice.

- 12 **LEAD REIN SP/SHP.** Open to riders 10 yrs. and under. Ponies not exceeding 122cm. Winner to receive the Lewis Logan Trophy.
- 13 **FIRST RIDDEN PONY.** Open to riders 12 yrs. and under. Ponies not exceeding 128cms. Winner to receive the Magnox North Trophy.
- 14 **M&M LEAD REIN PONY** Open to riders 10 yrs. and under. Ponies not to exceed 122cms.
- 15 **M&M FIRST RIDDEN PONY.** Open to riders 12yrs and under. Ponies not to exceed 128cms.



MINI CHAMPIONSHIP



Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 12 to 15. Will be judged following completion of class 15.

- 16 **BEST TURNED OUT HORSE AND RIDER.** Open to horses 4 yrs. old and over, exceeding 153cms. Winner to receive the Ramsay School of Motoring Trophy.
- 17 **RIDING CLUB HORSE.** Open to horses 4 yrs. old and over, exceeding 148cms. A small jump may be included at the judge's discretion. Winner to receive the Norma Burns Shield.
- 18 **NOVICE HORSE.** Open to horses 4 yrs. old and over, exceeding 153cms not to have won any open ridden class before 1st January 2018. Winner to receive the Sylverwood Cup.
- 19 **RIDDEN HUNTER/RIDING HORSE.** Open to horses 4 yrs. old and over, 158cm and over. Winner to receive the Laurelston Trophy.



HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP



Open to 1st and 2nd Prize Winners from classes 17-19. Will be judged following completion of class 20
Winner to receive THE BLACKSTON TROPHY.

20 YOUNGSTOCK SP/SHP. Open to stallion, mare or gelding 3 years old or under. Handlers of stallions to have attained their 14th birthday before the date of the show.

21 IN HAND COLOURED HORSE OR PONY*. Open to horses or ponies 4 yrs. old and over, any height, any type.

22 IN HAND VETERAN HORSE OR PONY – 15 YEARS AND OVER. * Open to horses or ponies any height, any type, handler any age.

23 IN HAND COB TRADITIONAL/GYPSY COB/HOGGED COB IN-HAND, 4-year-old and over, stallion mare or gelding.

24 INHAND HEAVY HORSE any age colt, stallion, mare or gelding, of any heavy draught breed; Clydesdale, Shire, Percheron, Suffolk Punch, Belgian Draught, Comtois, Ardennes etc.

25 RIDDEN COLOURED HORSE OR PONY*. Open to horses or ponies 4year old and over, any height, any type, rider any age.

***In the event of insufficient entries, classes 21 and 25 will be amalgamated**

26 RIDDEN VETERAN HORSE OR PONY – 15 YEARS AND OVER. * Open to horses or ponies any height, any type, rider any age.

28 RIDDEN HEAVY HORSE 4-year-old and over, stallion, mare or gelding, of any heavy draught breed; Clydesdale, Shire, Percheron, Suffolk Punch, Belgian Draught, Comtois, Ardennes etc.

RING 3 – 11AM PROMPT

£8 PER CLASS

- 29 LEAD REIN/ ASSISTED WHP**, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 143cm (14hh approx.) Riders not to have attained their 16th birthday before 1st January in the current year. This class is open to both Mountain and Moorland and plaited ponies. Maximum height of fences 50cm. Any rider competing in this class may not compete in any other WHP class at this show.
- 30 NOVICE MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND WORKING HUNTER** Open to stallion, mare or gelding 4 years or over. Height of fences up to approx. 55cms.
- 31 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY.** Open to ponies 4 years old and over, under 153cms. Height of fences up to approx. 65cms. Winner to receive Novice Working Hunter Pony Salver
- 32 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER HORSE.** Open to horses 4 years old and over, 153cms and over. Height of fences up to approx. 75cms. Winner to receive Novice Working Hunter Horse Trophy.

- 33 OPEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND WORKING HUNTER.** Open to stallion, mare or gelding 4 years or over. Height of fences up to approx. 75cms. Winner to receive M&M Working Hunter Salver.
- 34 WORKING HUNTER PONY 133CMS**_Open WHP, mare or gelding, 4 years and over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year
***Ponies placed 1st – 4th will qualify for The Land Rover Blair Castle WHP Championship to be held at the Land Rover Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Thursday 22nd August 2019. Qualification may go down to 6th place if higher placed ponies have previously qualified.**
- 35 WORKING HUNTER PONY 143CMS**_Open WHP, mare or gelding, 4 years and over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms, Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January of the current year
***Ponies placed 1st – 4th will qualify for The Land Rover Blair Castle WHP Championship to be held at the Land Rover Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Thursday 22nd August 2019. Qualification may go down to 6th place if higher placed ponies have previously qualified.**
- 36 WORKING HUNTER PONY 153CMS**_Open WHP, mare or gelding, 4 years and over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 153cms, Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January of the current year.
***Ponies placed 1st – 4th will qualify for The Land Rover Blair Castle Championship to be held at the Land Rover Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Thursday 22nd August 2019. Qualification may go down to 6th place if higher placed ponies have previously qualified.**
- 37 OPEN WORKING HUNTER HORSE.** Open to horses 4 years old and over, 153 cms and over. Height of fences up to approx. 95cms. winner to receive the Open Working Hunter Horse Salver.

Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 33 to 37 Will be judged after completion of class 37

SHOWJUMPING

RING 4- 11AM PROMPT

£6 PER CLASS (PRE-ENTRY)

- 38 NOVICE HORSE (65 CMS).** Open to horses, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms. Combination not to have won 1st place in any other jumping competition. Winner to receive the Dawn Perpetual Trophy.
- 39 INTERMEDIATE HORSE (75 CMS).** Open to horses, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms. Winner to receive the Sooty Memorial Trophy.
- 40 OPEN HORSE (85CMS).** Open to horses, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms. Winner to receive the Tartan Shield.
- 41 LEAD REIN PONY (cross poles).** Open to ponies not exceeding 148cms. Riders 10 years and under not to have competed in any jumping class off the lead rein. One round which will be against the clock.
- 42 STARTER STAKES (50CMS).** Open to ponies not exceeding 148cms. Riders aged 16 years and under. Pony/rider combination not to have been placed 1st in a jumping competition off the lead rein. Winner to receive The Tweedie Trophy.
- 43 NOVICE PONY (65CMS).** Open to ponies 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Winner to receive the Novice Pony Salver.
- 44 INTERMEDIATE PONY (75CMS).** Open to ponies 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Winner to receive the Twix Trophy.
- 45 OPEN PONY (85CMS).** Open to ponies 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms.

CLEAR ROUNDS WILL BE AVAILABLE UPON COMPLETION OF SHOWJUMPING, TIME AND WEATHER PERMITTING. ADJUST TO OWN HEIGHT & VOLUNTEERS AVAILABLE TO ASSIST. RIDERS MAY PRESENT THEMSELVES AT ANY TIME AND PAY AT GATE. £3 PER ROUND OR 2 FOR £5 AND ROSETTES FOR ALL CLEARS.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Hard hat with safety harness secured must be worn when mounted and conform to current approved BSI standards. Please ensure you are familiar with these and your hat complies with updated regulations.
- Allocated numbers must be worn when competing. Failure to do so will result in immediate elimination.
- Foul language and abuse of horses and ponies will not be tolerated and will result in immediate elimination.
- The organisers make every effort to avoid classes clashing, but in the event of a clash, the competitor must decide in which class they wish to compete. Entries will NOT be refunded.
- The winners of perpetual trophies are responsible for its safe return to the Show Secretary in time for the following years show. The committee reserves the right to issue alternative trophies and in the event a trophy is not available on the day of the show the Secretary will make every effort to ensure the competitor receives their trophy as soon as possible after the show.
- Online and postal entries only and close on Wednesday 15 May 2019. There will be no refunds for cancellations after that date unless a vet's certificate is provided. Entries will not be refunded on or after the day of the show. No other form of entry will be accepted i.e. phone/email/message.
- Online entries via PayPal and an administration cost will be added prior to payment.
- Postal entries will only be accepted if accompanied by payment.
- Entries on the day may be taken and only at the Secretaries discretion. All classes entered on the day with cost £8 and cash only accepted.
- The age of the rider shall be that on the date of the show.
- Handlers of stallions must be experienced and have attained their 14th birthday before the date of the show.
- The organisers reserve the right to divide classes if warranted or combine classes in the event of insufficient entries.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entries.
- The organisers accept no liability whatsoever for any loss, injury or damage to any pony, horse, competitor, spectator, vehicle, trailer or property however caused.
- The Judge's decision is final. Any abuse of judges or officials will not be accepted, and anyone perceived to be conducting themselves in an abusive manner will be asked to leave the showfield and no refund of entry monies will be made.
- Any objections that arise MUST be lodged with the Secretary along with a £25.00 deposit up to ½ hr following the event concerned. The deposit will be returned if the objection is sustained.
- Please ensure that you have your equine passport available for review. Remember that no horse or pony should travel without their passport.
- In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the committee will refund fees, less reasonable incurred expenses, on receipt of a refund request by the competitor within 2 weeks of the show date.
